The kids are back for Term 2 and if like me you are desperate for some alternatives to sandwiches, checkout this delicious empanada recipe! You can switch out the mince for shredded ham with pizza sauce, or even make sweet ones with stewed apples and pears. Grab yourself some dumpling makers (Kmart have them) and get the kids involved!

INGREDIENTS

- 2 sheets shortcrust pastry
- 500 grams lean beef mince
- 1 pack taco seasoning
- 1/2 zucchini (grated)
- 1/2 carrot (grated)
- 100 gram cheddar cheese (shredded)

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 180°C fan forced. Line a baking tray with baking paper, set aside.
- 2. In a frypan, brown the meat and add in the taco seasoning and the grated zucchini and carrot. Cook for 20 minutes or until cooked through.
- 3. Using a dumpling cutter, shape and cut the pastry to fit the dumpling moulds.
- 4. Add about 1 heaping tablespoon of taco meat to the centre of each dumpling, keeping in the dumpling maker while doing so.
- 5. Sprinkle cheese on top of the taco meat, then use the dumpling maker to close and seal the dumplings. Place on the baking tray.
- 6. Lightly spray the empanadas with Olive oil and bake for 12-15 minutes, or until the empanadas are a golden brown.
- 7. Remove from oven and allow to cool for 5 minutes
- 8. Serve with a condiment of choice: sauce, sour cream, salsa, guacamole (optional). Enjoy!
