NEW BUILDING UPDATE

Works on our new building have continued this week. Telstra cables have been re-routed in preparation for the building demolition. As mentioned last week, demolition will be paid for and completed outside of our budget so this is a big win for our KG building project.

Site preparations for our portable classroom have also begun. The building will be located in the open grass area south of the basketball court so children will be close to specialists, toilets and the play areas. Grade 3/4D and 3/4H will be located in the new portable building which will be the same size as our existing double portables. 1/2F will relocate into 3/4H leaving 1/2C in the open area. We will take advantage of the available space to create a large room for 1/2C and relocate the library shelves which will be a great outcome for everyone working in our ALC building.


